At least once a year the membership is entitled to a financial report to advise the status of the Club's finances. Below is a table that shows the budget for calendar year 2014 and the actual results for the year as well as a budget for 2015 that has been approved by the Board.

The Board has approved having another 5K run and walk during Pride weekend in Palm Springs as the major fund-raiser for the Club in 2015. Keith Culver has volunteered to be Race Director and will be organizing a Steering Committee to help with planning and organizing the event.

Most of the Club's revenues come from membership dues, which have been increased for the membership year starting February 1, 2015, to \$35 from \$30. The Club also enjoys some revenue from local businesses that advertise in our newsletters. The Club also generates a net profit from the trips that are organized by the Club. Trip prices are set to insure that the Club does not lose money if a trip does not sell out, and to encourage membership in the Club by charging more to non-members. The effect of these policies for the past few years has been to generate a small profit for the Club.

General expenses include maintenance fees for the Club's website (based on an amount per month for each active member) and credit card fees. General expenses also include approximately \$2,000 per year for insurance and for dues to belong to the Road Runners Club of America that is the umbrella organization for our Club to be a non-profit organization under federal and state tax laws.

Social expenses include Club costs for the annual anniversary dinner, which is partially subsidized by the Club, the Pride weekend reception, the Christmas party, potlucks and other social events.

A new expense for 2015 is for participation in the Pride 5K Run and Walk. Although no Pride Run/Walk was held in 2014, it has been an annual event for the past few years. One of the Club's objectives, in addition to promoting health and fitness through walking and running, is to contribute to our local community, and the Pride Run/Walk is the only fund-raising event that historically the Club has pursued. To encourage participation in the 2015 Pride Run/Walk, the Board has budgeted to pay the registration costs of Club members who will walk or run in the event.

The PrideRun/Walk has historically had one or two designated local charitable organizations as beneficiaries, and in addition, the Club has made year-end donations to the Center (where the Board has its monthly meetings) and to Mizell. These year-end donations are budgeted to continue for 2015.

The budget for 2014 planned for a net loss of \$100 but in fact, the Club generated a gain of \$2,258 by having slightly higher revenues than budgeted and by under-spending expenses. The budget approved for 2015 plans for a loss of \$2,350. The Club has sufficient cash on hand to absorb this loss, and the Board preferred this approach rather than increasing dues by a greater amount.

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






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
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
